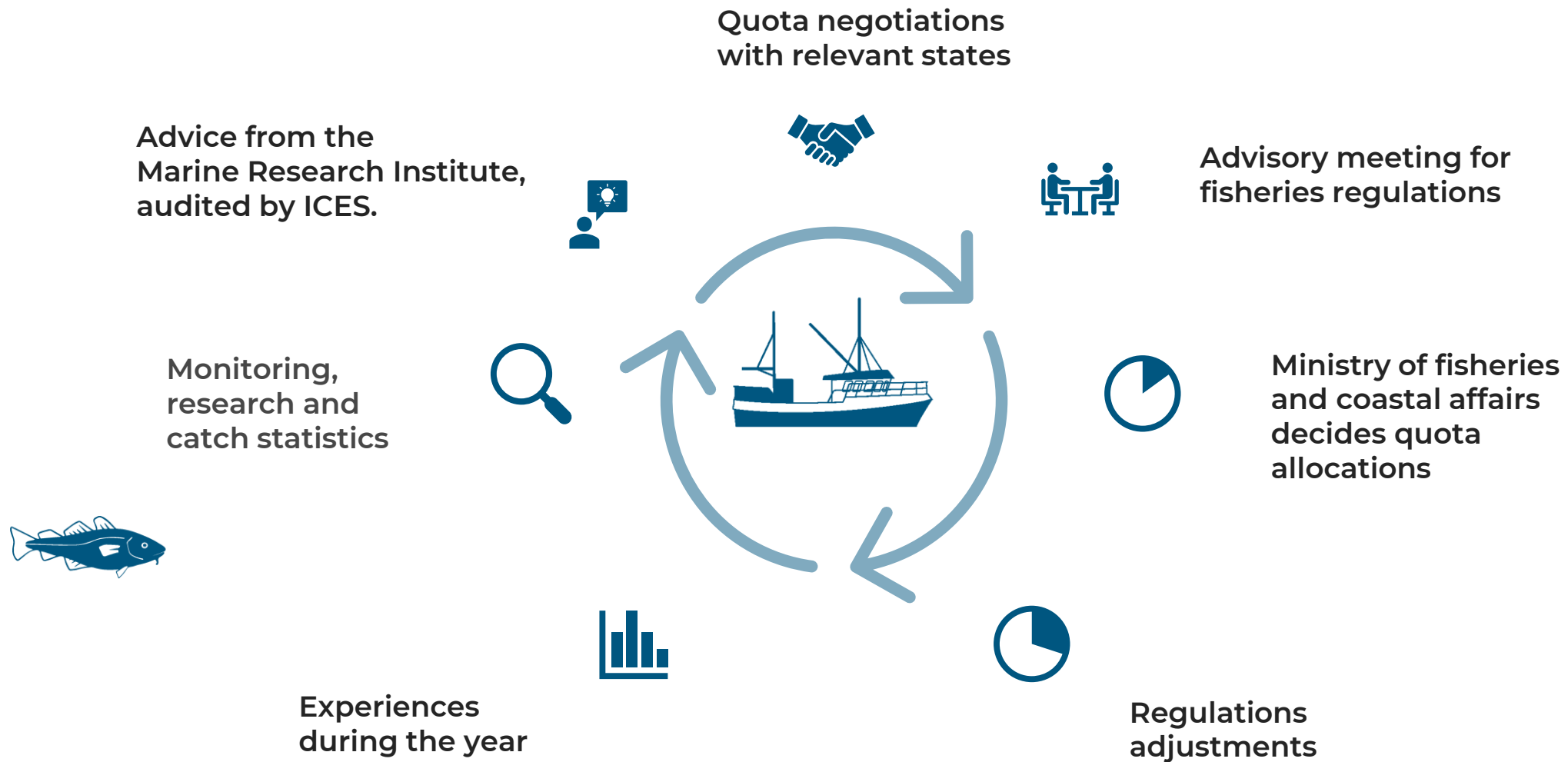

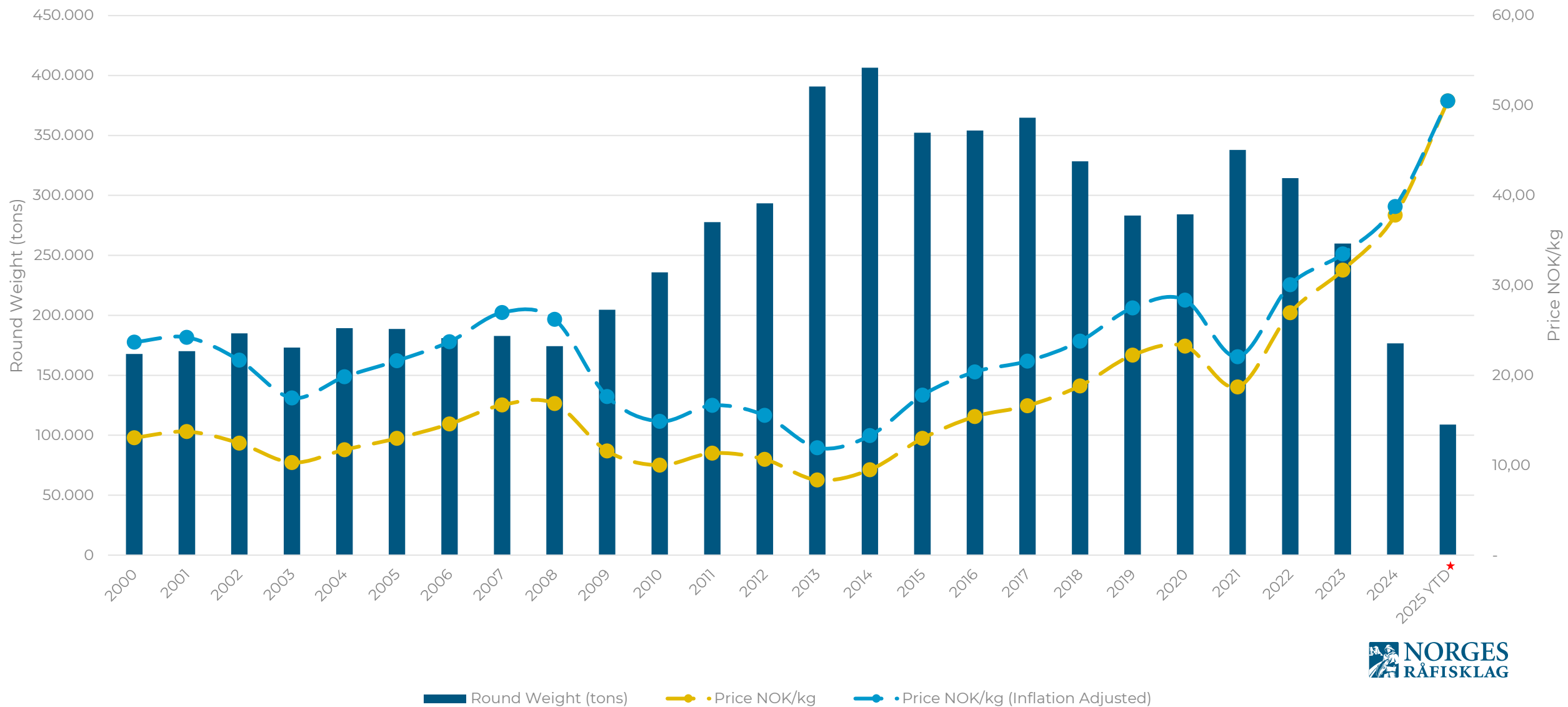

The regulatory wheel



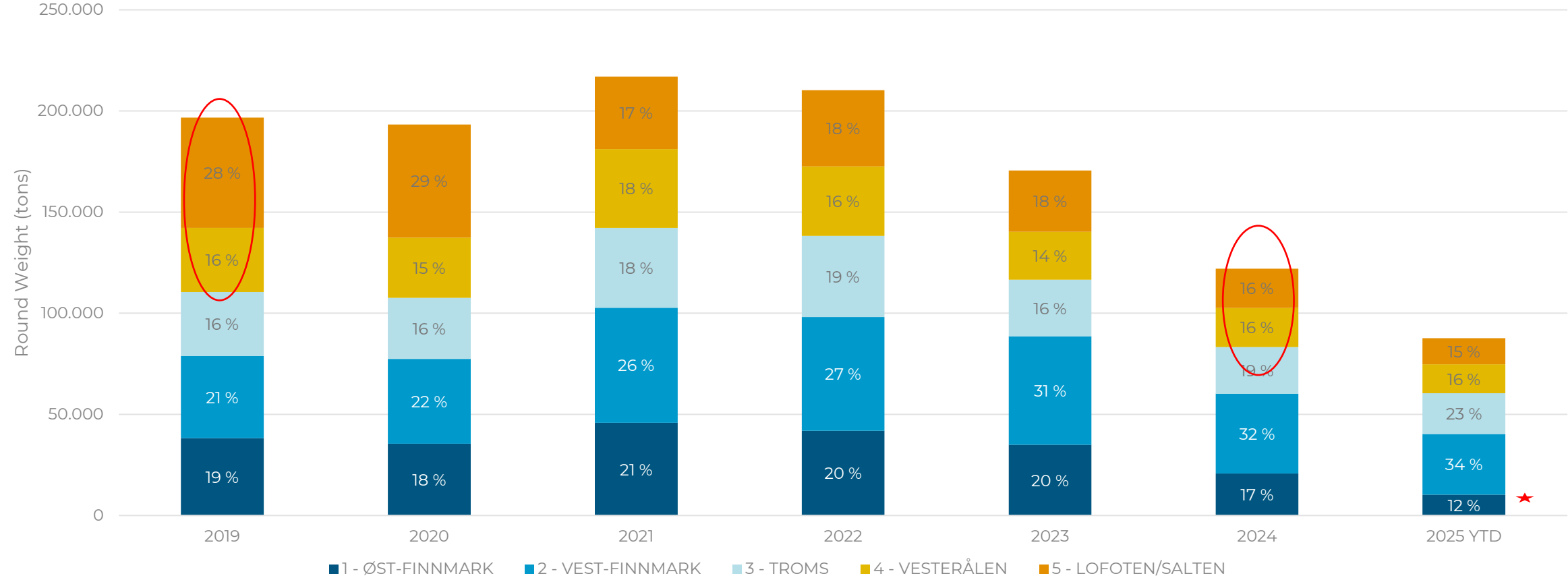
Cod landings since 2000
