Yu Sheng', which literally means 'raw fish', signifies an abundance of wealth and longevity. A must-have traditional starter at every Lunar New Year feast, Yu Sheng is no stranger to the Chinese. Over the 15 days of festive celebrations, a colourful array of condiments, sauces and thinly shredded vegetables are served on a platter together with Norwegian Salmon, then tossed to auspicious Chinese greetings. Ingredients include white and green radishes, carrots, capsicums, turnips and pickled ginger.

Lo Hei

Every Lunar New Year, families, friends and business associates gather to 'Lo Hei' on separate occasions. Before 'Lo Hei' commences, everyone at the table will rise from their seats and proceed to use their chopsticks to toss the ingredients into the air together while saying 'auspicious wishes' aloud. It is believed that the higher the toss is, the greater the fortunes will be.
